Hunter fined \$1,000 for trespassing after shooting deer on side of road

A Parry Sound man has been fined \$1,000 for trespassing for the purpose of hunting after shooting a deer and recovering it from private property.

Robert Thomas Burns was convicted of trespassing for the purpose of hunting and prohibited from hunting for one year. His rifle, which was seized at the time, will be returned upon payment of the fine.

Court heard that on Nov. 2, 2009, Burns was travelling south

on James Bay Junction Road when a deer crossed the road in front of him. He exited his vehicle and shot the deer as it stood in the ditch beside the road. The deer died on private property and was recovered by Burns. The trespass was reported by the property owner, who witnessed the deer being recovered.

Self-employed workers eligible for EI benefits

Beginning Jan. 30, 2010, self-employed workers will be eligible to receive EI benefits.

In the past, people who worked for themselves were ineligible for EI payments because they did not meet the traditional definition of an employee receiving a salary with automatic payroll deductions for this insurance.

Self-employed workers are now eligible to receive four special benefits: maternity leave; parental benefits are available for up to 50 weeks to a weekly maximum of \$457; sickness coverage is available for up to 15 weeks with a

medical certificate stating the expected duration of the absence; and six weeks is available for workers who require compassionate leave to care for a sick relative.

Self-employed workers are encouraged to register for EI benefits between Jan. 30, 2010, and April 1, 2010, to be eligible to receive benefits as early as Jan. 1, 2011. The program requires that premiums be received by the government before claims may be received by applicants.
